Dog Food: We feed LIFE'S ABUNDANCE LARGE BREED Puppy food until 15 months of age and then transition to LIFE'S ABUNDANCE ALL STAGES. Please DO NOT feed any other brand of dog food until your puppy has been acclimated to his/her new home (for up to 1 month from your puppy's arrival date). To reduce the risk of Hip Dysplasia, other Intestinal and autoimmune disorders, please consider keeping your puppy/dog healthier by remaining on the LIFE'S ABUNDANCE diet. Please use the package instructions as a feeding **guide**. Should you have a need to change their diet, for whatever reason, please consult with Central Coast German Shepherds for alternative options and/or recommendations. 80% of Hip Dysplasia is caused by environmental factors such as early spay and neuter and lack of quality Diet. Only 20% is Genetic and subject to controlled breeding practices. We do our part. PLEASE do yours.

Other:

FLEA MEDICATION: We use **Soresto Collars (can be taken off if reactions where other medications cannot be removed once administered). Frontline or Advantage ONLY- for topicals or Bravecto.** Your puppy has not been started on flea medication.

HEARTWORM MEDICATION: **Heartguard** Your puppy has not been started.

JOINT HEALTH & IMMUNE SUPPORT: NuVet Plus and NuJoint. These supplements help with Immune System Support and Joint Support. Refer to our NUVet page on our website for details. **NUVet ORDER CODE: 973808**
